**ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE 183.04 REGARDING THE
EFFECTIVE END DATE OF THAT ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council finds that Chapter 183.04 of the Codified Ordinances shall be amended to correct the effective date of Chapter 183 to end December 31, 2015 in order to be supplemented by the amendments incorporated in H. B. 5.; and

WHEREAS, upon a detailed review of H. B. 5 and the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Boston Heights, this Ordinance is found and determined by this Council to be necessary and pertinent so the Council can enact the amendments required prior to the January 1, 2016 deadline and to be in accord with the provisions and limitations specified in Chapter 718 of the Revised Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That Codified Ordinance Chapter 183.04 be hereby amended and replaced with the following language:

- a. The tax shall be levied, collected and paid with respect to the salaries, wages, commissions and other compensation, and with respect to the net profits of businesses, professions or other activities earned on or after the effective date of this chapter.
- b. This Chapter shall remain in effect for tax years through 2015.
- c. Despite the effective end date, any hearings, appeals, or any other matter governed by this chapter and relating to tax year 2015 shall be heard in accordance with the procedures and terms established in this Chapter 183.
- d. This Chapter will have no effect over tax years beginning January 1st, 2016.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is in the best interests and public safety of the Village of Boston Heights and its residents.

Section 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of the Village residents and to allow for timely compliance with new state tax law, and the continued operations of the Village Fiscal Officer, and other departments and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
