2016-2017 Capital Projects

- ◆ Roadways in "the Ledges" have been repaired and repaved with driveway apron tie ins, berm topsoil and seeding work recently completed & Akron Cleveland Road from Rt 303 to the village southern boundary was paved in October 2016.
- ◆ The repaving contract for the Wooded View roadways was awarded by Council and work will begin in Spring of 2017.
- ◆ Culvert repairs & road repairs for Olde Eight Road will occur next year and Olde Eight Road resurfacing with base repair will occur later 2017. The culvert project received a 70% grant from OPWC and the road refurbishing project has a 80% federal highway funds grant.

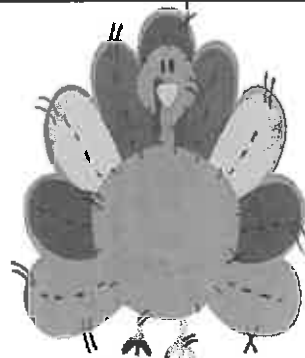
APPRECIATION DAY

Mayor's Report:

The Village of Boston Heights

The Akron-Cleveland Road and roadways in the Ledges were paved this year with the roadways in Wooded View contracted by Council for a Spring 2017 repair and resurfacing.

Village Council has approved a negotiated fire service contract with Valley Fire District for a ten year period.

November 8, 2016 is Election Day and the village road levy is on the ballot for renewal. Monies from this road levy pay for snow plowing, grass cutting and roadway and right of way maintenance. These monies subsidize the grant dollars we receive for road repaving, replacing culverts and other infrastructure projects. **This is not a new tax.**

The Dominion East Ohio Gas Training facility is proposing a partial opening in November with full operation in 2017. The new facility is located at 418 East Hines Hill Road.
