AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENTS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF BOSTON HEIGHTS, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinance of Boston Heights, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, Numerous sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly; and,

WHEREAS, Council has entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revisions which are now before Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1: That the editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Boston Heights, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to-wit:

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the current version of the Boston Heights Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, law enforcement, the daily operation and avoid legal entanglements, including conflict with general State law, and therefore shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
