POLICE OFFICER REQUIREMENTS

The Village of Boston Heights is dedicated to employing police officers who meet the highest of standards. Boston Heights Police Officers must demonstrate moral and ethical behavior in all their actions in the fair administration of the law. Officers must also be present in the community, responsive to civilian needs, and able to carry out the responsibilities with which they are entrusted.

Officers must be able to communicate effectively, identify problems quickly, and creatively find solutions. They must also demonstrate sound judgment and decision-making and remain unbiased, particularly when assessing behavior or handling emergencies.

DUTIES MAY INCLUDE:

- ✔ Issuing warning or citations
- ✔ Directing traffic
- ✔ Investigate crash scenes
- ✔ Preserve and file evidence
- ✔ Interview suspects, witnesses and victims
- ✔ Provide credible court testimony
