**AN ORDINANCE DEPOSITING \$15,000 FROM MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX REVENUE ANNUALLY TO THE PARK FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio as follows:


**Section 1:** That the Village Council authorizes and directs the Fiscal Officer to, beginning with the year 2018, deposit \$15,000.00 annually from the General Fund, and in particular the revenue generated by the municipal income tax, in the Park Fund.

**Section 2:** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to do all things and take all lawful action necessary to deposit and/or the aforesaid \$15,000.00 from the General Fund, and in particular the revenue generated by municipal income tax every year, to the Park Fund as set forth herein.

**Section 3:** That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance was taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 4:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of the Village residents, and to timely transfer funds in 2018 given the onset of warmer weather and the need to fund the Park Fund, and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
